## Voting instructions

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- In parallel, based on panel discussions, a list of technical challenges will be created by an independent moderator (Bryan Rice). List will be displayed on the left projector.
- Our goal is to come up with about Ten Top Technical challenges for EUV Sources, based on supplier presentations and panel discussions.
- In the end of panel discussions, during break, everyone will vote on the list of technical challenges – to allow us to create an industry voted list of “Top Ten Challenges for the EUV Source Technology.”
- We will then have ten flip charts on the walls, one each for every topic.
- One votes by putting their votes (In form of dots, provided with your badge) on the flip chats.
- There are Five Votes per persons– two person max. per company.
